

INFORMATION FOR PATIENTS

Consultations take place in the rooms in Duncraig
(Suite 4 / 64 Arnisdale Road – Duncraig)

Mr Fisher operates privately at Glengarry Hospital and both privately and publicly, at Joondalup Health Campus

You will be sent an Appointment Confirmation Letter either by Post or Email.
This letter will include confirmation of the date & time of your appointment, the costs of consultation and any costs for examinations that may be performed during your consultation, if required

On the day of consultation, you will need to bring the following with you:
(If you have not already forwarded the relevant information by return email prior to your appointment)

- Referral letter from your GP / Specialist / Hospital
(Medicare will not refund your rebate if we do not have a copy of your referral on file)
- Medicare Card / Veteran's Affairs Card
- Private Health Insurance Details - *if applicable*
- Any relevant x-ray reports / scan reports / hearing tests etc.

If your appointment is due to sinus problems a recent CT scan is essential.
Please organise this with your GP prior to your consultation.

If your appointment is for ear/hearing/tinnitus problems a recent hearing test (audiogram) is essential
Please organise this prior to your consultation.

Consultations are privately billed and payable in FULL on the day of consultation.
(EFTPOS is available – We accept most major credit cards – excl. American Express & Diners)

Veteran's holding a Gold Card will have their accounts sent directly to the Department of Veteran's Affairs.

If you require surgery, we will provide you with an estimate of costs for the procedure.
